2017 is a very special year for RSPB South Stack, we are celebrating our 40th birthday this year. We will be holding special events throughout the year. With its fascinating history, breathtaking landscape and wonderful wildlife, this reserve is one of Anglesey's treasures. Whether you've visited our reserve previously, or have never been before, then this is the year to experience what it has to offer.



On the Reserve February sees the guillemots and razorbills start to return to the cliffs during the day time in readiness for the nesting season.

Our winter residential volunteer Sarah is busy digging our pond and nature garden that has been paid for with thanks to funding that we won from the Tesco Bags of Help scheme.

We are undertaking a small amount of cutting work using a Rytec cutting machine on the Range. This work will only be carried out when the weather is dry to minimize damage to the paths.

We are also continuing with our public consultation and information meetings to tell residents about our plans to close shepherd graze on the Range for 40 days. Close shepherd grazing is a method of grazing where the shepherd and his dog remains with the sheep all day and controls the areas that they graze.
